

DOES YOUR CHILD HAVE ASTHMA?

This year students and teachers are learning more about asthma so that we can make sure our school is an "Asthma-Friendly" place. An Asthma-Friendly school means:

- ✓ School staff know which students have asthma
- ✓ Students with asthma can get to their medications easily when they need them
- ✓ Staff and students know how to help if someone is having trouble with their asthma
- ✓ Everyone is able to take part in all school activities

If your child has asthma please fill out the bottom of this letter and have your child return it to their teacher.

Once we have received the tear-off from you we will send home:

- Information about any upcoming asthma events in our school.
- Asthma information (from the Lung Association)
- A Student Asthma Management Form for you to complete. This form lets the school know about your child's asthma. The form asks you to list your child's triggers and warning signs and when to use their puffer. Please have your child return the completed form to their teacher.
